


Pakistan: Effects of Monsoon Flooding




Deaths as a Result of Flooding by District



Flash floods on the Kabul and Swat Rivers washed away homes, bridges, and roads, isolating many villages, displacing one million people, and killing hundreds of individuals. According to the Government of Pakistan, the three districts recording the highest death toll (8/4) are Nowshera, Shangla, and Swat in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province.
